THE MOORFIELDS EYE HOSPITAL CHILDREN'S WING ARTISTS DESIGN SCHEDULE WALL COMMISSION

1. The Design

- 1.1 The artist will propose a work which will treat a dominant wall of the Paediatric Wing which first appears at the public entrance and thence is exposed at different levels of the building. (See plans provided by architects Penoyre & Prasad).
- 1.2 The proposed design will be a coherent treatment which will be legible as one work where ever it is seen.
- 1.3 With the aid of site drawings, visiting the site and a dialogue with the architects, the client and its agents, the artist will receive all the support needed to make a proposal.
- 1.4 The proposal will be accompanied by a written description of how it will be implemented and a detailed budget itemizing the costs.
- 1.5 The budget for the work will be £25,000 inclusive but exempt of VAT.
- 1.6 The design can be photographic montage, drawings or a maquette although the latter is not essential. The design should be shown on 3 pages of paper no larger than A1.

2. The work

- 2.1 The artists will take into consideration the opportunities the building affords and the physical constrains which will be in place once the work is due to be installed.
- 2.2 The best quality material should be employed in the implementation of the work given the constraints of the budget.
- 2.3 Consideration must be made on the future maintenance costs and longevity of the work where the work should be robust and potential, future maintenance costs should be kept to a minimum. Access and proximity to human traffic and use of the building for children and their families should also be considered. Materials

used must take into account the behaviour of children of all ages.

3. The fees

3.1 The design fee is £1,000 inclusive, half of which will be paid (on sight of invoice) on return of the signed contract, the remainder to be paid on completion and submission of the proposal.
