Here Now is a moving image projection onto the cliffs in Lulworth Cove.

Devised by Charlie Morrissey, and using the UNESCO World Heritage Site as backdrop, stage and cinema screen, this event draws our attention to the global significance of the site by reflecting on the meaning of Outstanding Universal Value. The work is a meditation reflecting on our fleeting time on the planet and uses images projected onto the cliff face to explore its geology, natural history and environment.

PVA MediaLab in partnership with The Jurassic Coast World Heritage Site have commissioned artist Charlie Morrissey to produce several site-specific works for the Jurassic Coast which reflect on its outstanding universal value. This series is entitled Deep Time and is the first from the 'Universal Value' commissioning strand.

The Deep Time series will conclude with 'Without Us' in summer 2010.
