# MOORFIELDS EYE HOSPITAL INTERNATIONAL CHILDREN'S EYE CENTRE DESIGN CONTRACT FOR THE BUILDING FACADE

#### **CONTRACT SCHEDULE**

## **The Work**

- 1. The Work will comprise a set of drawings describing the layout of the façade louver blades, based on initial designs developed by Penoyre & Prasad LLP for Moorfields Eye Hospital International Children's Eye Centre (see attached design).
- 2. The artist will take into account the technical constraints imposed by the architects including the number of blades, dimensions and material of the blades, and how they will be attached to the tension cables on the façade. The blades will shade the glazed areas of the building to provide sufficient reduction in solar gain.
- 3. The Artist will determine the arrangement and colour(s) in accordance to agreements made in discussion with the Architects.
- 4. The Artist will complete large scale drawings of the design which will then be interpreted into a computerised image by the Architects.
- 5. The Artist will advise and discuss with the Architects appropriate materials and colours for the design.
- 6. The Artist will attend meetings with the Architects and make necessary site visits as it is relevant to the completion of the design.
- 7. The Artist shall undertake to work in accordance with all rules imposed by Others on behalf of the Commissioner or its agents in connection with the Work.
- 8. The Architects or its agents shall obtain all necessary statutory approvals for the production of the Work.
- 9. The equipment and materials for the realization of the façade design will be purchased and/or fabricated and installed by the Main Contractor or its agents in accordance with the design specification.

## **Delivery Date**:

1. The Work should be completed by 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2004 unless extended to a later date by the Architects and in agreement with the Artist.

#### Schedule of Payment of Fees:

- 2. Penoyre and Prasad LLP will pay the Artist £4,000 based on a daily rate of consultancy. This amount will include fee, materials, travel costs and expenses.
  - Stage 1: £3,000, Upon completion of large scale drawings of final design
  - Stage 2: £1,000, Upon completion of collaboration with Architects
  - All costs are exclusive of VAT.

•	The Artist will be responsible for his/her own tax, VAT, national insurance payments, occupational insurance and public liability and indemnity.
